CLARISSA RODRIGUEZ: Welcome. My name is Clarissa Rodriguez, former Chair of the New York State Workers' Compensation Board. Before we start the meeting, as many of you know, Freida has been a Board member since 2009 and Vice Chair since 2019.

compensation appeals and helped the agency's efforts
to modernize its systems and processes. She also had
an important role in implementing New York State Paid

day-to-day oversight and management of the agency and
the Full Board.

Freida has decades of professional experience in the areas of education, government, civic service and public relations. Prior to joining the Workers'

Compensation Board, she was a public relations specialist at Bunson -- Burson-Marsteller where she managed the firm's largest account, Help America Vote Act, and organized the citywide education campaign for New York City's voting system transition from manual to electronic machines. She has created and organized

many state-level initiatives, including being a founding creator of the New York State's comprehensive celebration of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday drives.

Freida has held membership on several boards, all with a focus on community and/or civic service as well as student leadership. She currently serves as Chair of the Harlem Community Development Corporation Board of Directors and for the CUNY School of Public Health Advisory Board. Additionally, she sits on the Community Advisory Board for Channel 13, WLIW.

Previously, she served as a trustee for the City
University of New York from 2006 to 2016 helping
oversee campus management trustees for the New York
City Employee Retirement System, trustee for the
Teacher's Retirement System, member of the New York
City Department of Education's panels for educational
policy and Board member for the Coro Leadership
Council, among others.

A lifelong Harlem resident, Freida holds a master's in corporate communications from the University of Wisconsin and a BA in communications from Hofstra University. Why am I telling you all of this? Because I want you to help me in congratulating

Report. Keith will present the Office of General

Counsel's Departmental report for June.

KEITH LONGDEN: Thank you very much, Madam Chair, and congratulations.

FREIDA FOSTER: Thank you very much.

KEITH LONGDEN: As every month, I'm going to give a brief statistical analysis from last month of the workflow of the three divisions in the Office of General Counsel that decide cases.

So June 2025 the Adjudication Division held
16,650 hearings, resolved 10,593 cases at hearing and
issued 412 Reserved Decisions. They also held 1,290
Pre-Hearing Conferences, finalized 1,983 Section 32
Waiver Agreements, and of those, 1,583 were decided at
hearing and 400 were approved via a desk review.

The Administrative Review Division received 1,004 applications, processed 1,018 applications for an end-of-month inventory of 8,515 cases. And finally, the Legal Affairs Division received 97 applications for a Full Board Review during the month, processed 61

2	end-of-month inventory of 3 236 cases. And that
3	concludes my report. Thank you.
