## Helping New Yorkers get back to work

Navigating a path back to work while recovering from an on-the-job injury or occupational disease can be challenging. The vocational rehabilitation counselors at the NYS Workers' Compensation Board (Board) help injured workers develop action plans to find or maintain employment. These services, always free of charge, can help you return to the workforce.

Board vocational rehabilitation counselors are skilled in supporting workers who experience job-related stress or other employment challenges. They can also assist with:

- Career counseling
- Vocational skill building
- Training
- Resume development
- Employment searches
- Language accessibility

Sometimes, workers can't simply return to a former job after injury. The Board's vocational rehabilitation counselors help injured workers identify interests and explore ways to obtain marketable skills. We're excited to share that injured workers may now be able to attend college for free under New York's SUNY and CUNY Reconnect initiatives.

### SUNY and CUNY Reconnect: College at no cost for New Yorkers

The Board has a new partnership with the State University of New York (SUNY) and the City University of New York (CUNY) to help injured employees return to work. SUNY/CUNY Reconnect programs are now open to all eligible New Yorkers (including injured workers) who wish to pursue a college education and learn new skills. The qualified degree programs focus on in-demand occupations such as health care, cybersecurity, and advanced manufacturing, among many others.

SUNY/CUNY Reconnect offers free associate degrees (two-year programs) to New Yorkers aged 25-55 who do not already possess a degree. It covers the costs of tuition, books, and supplies for any of the eligible programs. There are options for both on-campus and online learning, with full or part-time attendance.
